ASF: A Step Forward	ASF was created by FSA as an annual event that introduces admitted and prospective high school students and junior transfers to the college environment of UCSC. It is a three day program that seeks to build social networks with these prospective students and encourage them to attend higher education. GENTE: Getting Educating Now To Empower	MEChA's annual conference, once known as Parent Student Conference was created to promote higher education within underrepresented Chicana/o and Latina/o communities. This program outreaches to both students and parents at all level of education to education them about the importance of higher education. They hold financial aid workshops, admissions requirements, and give space to discuss issues affecting the community.	SIOC allocated money to be used for conference costs: food for entire conference, vehicles, gas, facilities, drivers from OPERS, childcare, copies, supplies and materials, entertainment services to White Hawk and Los Mejicas, t-shirts, programs, decorations, parking permits, and directional signs.	12/3/08	\$11,286.00
DHE: Destination Higher Education	Destination Higher Education was created by the African/Black Student Association here at UCSC. The goal of the program is to continue to motivate and expose students to the UCSC campus and encourage them to go on to an institution of higher learning. This is a three-day program that conducts workshops and caucuses to give the students a peer-to-peer college going perspective.	The allocation will be used for program start up costs, which includes: rental cars, gas cards, parking permits, charter buses, plane tickets, lodging, copies, stamps, t-shirts, sweatshirts, venues, and food.	12/9/08	\$11,166.00
LIFTED: Liberating Individuals, Fostering Thought in Education & Diversity	LIFTED is a non-yield outreach program that works towards making Higher Education accessible for communities that have been historically underrepresented within the University. This was a pilot program, whose development began a year ago. LIFTED came out of Engaging Education's Board of Directors Strategic Plan. The Board identified three necessary areas of growth for the center and out of those three areas, came a need for a non-yield, multicultural program that brings high school youth to the UC campus to teach them about accessing higher education. The program was initially designed with the purpose of expanding the ways in which the center outreaches to underrepresented communities.	Funds will be used for honorariums for workshop facilitators, Conference Services for dorms for the participants, t-shirts, food, backpacks, conference & school supplies, and TAPS parking permits.	7/23/08	\$5,531.00
MC: Motivation Conference	Motivation Conference is a three-day program created by APISA that focuses on bring "at-risk" high school students from different community centers to UCSC and engaging with college students. The program offers students various workshops that shows them the opportunities that await them within higher education. ORALE: Oportunidades Rumbo A La Educaci3n	ORALE: Oportunidades Rumbo A La Educacion Created from MEChA, this program seeks to engage Chicana/o and Latina/o high school seniors and transfer students to seek a higher education. This is a free three day program that provides workshops on resources available on the UCSC campus. The program also emphasizes cultural pride and community building tools to survive in this university.	The funds will be used for program start up costs.
